**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

**THIS CAUSE** is before the Court upon the Order to Show Cause For Failure to Comply with Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m) [DE 7] (“Order to Show Cause”). This case was filed on March 21, 2012. On July 16, 2012, the Court entered an Order to Show Cause which instructed Plaintiff to show cause no later than July 25, 2012, why service had not been perfected on the Defendant within 120 days of filing of the complaint as required by Rule 4(m) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. The Court advised that failure to comply with the Order to Show Cause would result in the dismissal of the case without prejudice. Plaintiff has failed to comply with the Order to Show Cause and there has been no other indication that service has been perfected on the Defendant.

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that this case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. The Clerk shall **CLOSE** the case and **DENY** any pending motions as **MOOT**.
